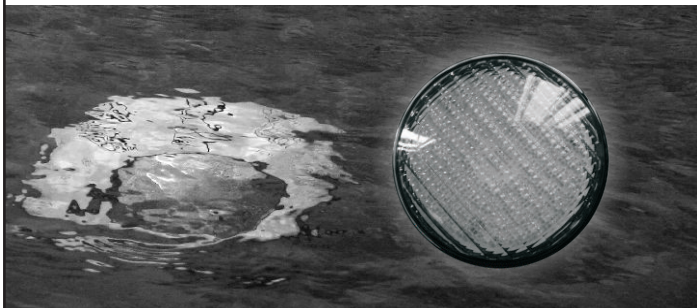


PAR56 LED Panel user manual

Keep this manual for future reference



⚠ SAFETY WARNINGS

- Only qualified electrician is allowed to carry out the installation of this product.
- Avoid direct contact with electrical power.
- Understand all regulations in effect for preventing accidents.
- Switch off power to transformer before repairing or replacing the light.
- Never handle with wet hands and feet.
- This unit is design for use only when fully submerged in water, please use with suitable transformer.

- Never operate this Underwater Light for more than 1 minute unless it is totally submerged in water.
- Be sure power is off before installing or removing LED plate. Allow LED plate to cool before replacing.
- This product should be installed according to your local electrical installation ordinances and regulations.
- Maximum Depth for Light installation at 1 meter.
- Maximum Water Temperature Range for light operation 0-30°C.

- ❶. 144 LEDs Bulb, Cool White, 12V/10W
- ❷. 144 LEDs Bulb, RGB, 12V/10W
- ❸. 252 LEDs Bulb, Cool White, 12V/16W
- ❹. 252 LEDs Bulb, RGB, 12V/16W
- ❺. 252 LEDs Bulb, RGB, With Remote Control, 12V/16W

Based on above specifications, you can select the quantity and color of the LED bulbs according to your individual preferences.

INSTALLATION & OPERATION

1. The light bulb PAR56 is suitable for underwater lights with various face plates and encasings popular in present market.
2. The installation and replacement procedure is based on the structure of each underwater light. For example, to replace bulb for underwater light EMAUX NP300, open the lamp first as shown in Fig. 1 and then connect the cord as shown in Fig. 2. (Notice: only bulbs with remote control need to be connected with a signal line.)
3. This bulb is a repair part for underwater lights equipped with light bulb PAR56. The only thing you need do is taking out the old PAR56 bulb and replace it with the new one. If you use the bulb in other brand underwater lights, you should make sure that the lamp panel fits in the underwater light.

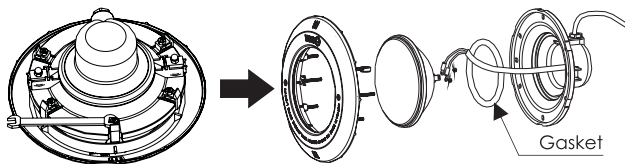
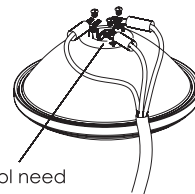

MAINTENANCE OF THE LIGHTS

- Do not leave the lights "on" without water for longer than 1 minute.
- Do not leave the lights directly under sunlight. Fill the pool with fresh water as soon as possible after the lights are installed.
- Before switching on the lights, check whether the lights are fully submerged underwater and the circuit boxes are running properly.
- This unit does not need any kind of maintenance. If it is not working properly, please contact EMAUX authorized dealer where you purchase the unit from.
- Warranty will be voided if the Emaux Underwater Light was dismantled by unauthorized personnel.
